The legs are adorned with remarkable chiseled bronze appliques depicting sphinx heads or classical caryatids, an emblematic motif of the Empire decorative repertoire inspired by Egypt and classical antiquity. The legs end in bronze feet shaped like lion's paws, a refined detail that accentuates the prestigious character of this

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piece. The piece as a whole demonstrates fine craftsmanship and a harmonious balance of proportions.
