Description

Large Venetian sideboard in the Baroque Chippendale style from the early 20th century, attributed to the Testolini Brothers, a renowned workshop active in the decorative arts between the 19th and 20th centuries. The piece stands out for its imposing mirror with a richly carved and gold-leafed frame, featuring elegant volutes and dramatic floral motifs. The top panel is made of original dark glass, embellished with refined gilded border decorations. The structure is crafted from solid wood with a fine blond walnut burl veneer, enhanced by ebonized frames that accentuate the color contrast. The original bronze handles, finely crafted in the shape of flowers, complete the piece with a touch of great elegance. The scalloped edges and scroll-shaped legs are hand-carved from solid walnut, featuring

refined volute motifs and floral decorations. The front and sides feature exquisite maple inlays, executed with great artisanal skill. The sideboard features a functional interior with shelves, while the central door is embellished with a sandblasted mirror featuring floral motifs and a contoured frame. The interior is equipped as a dry bar with integrated lighting, which further enhances its elegance and functionality. A piece of furniture of great charm and quality, embodying the excellence of early 20th-century Venetian cabinetmaking.
