A stunning Cuval Sinanli from Malatya in southeastern Anatolia. Cuval are large carrying bags used by nomadic peoples to store grain and transport it during their migrations. Each of these items bears the distinctive marks of its owners, which are directly linked to their geographic origin. Woven wool on wool. The weaving is a true marvel, matching the piece's aesthetic appeal. Extremely fine, precise, and even, the piece is both supple and lightweight. Yet it remains exceptionally sturdy. Composed exclusively of plant-based dyes in perfect harmony, enhanced by the use of white cotton that brings out the contrasts.
