The group is set in a wooded scene opening onto a luminous landscape. 18th-century Italian school. Paolo Monaldi was an Italian painter born in 1710 and died in 1779. Associated with the Rococo style, he was trained in the studio of Paolo Anesi and influenced by Andrea Locatelli. He specialized in bambocciate, genre scenes depicting everyday life and rural settings. He contributed to the decorations of Villa Chigi for Cardinal Flavio Chigi. Oil on canvas.
