### Description

Claude Desseaux Flower in a Green Pot Oil on canvas exhibited at the 1976 Salon des Artistes Français Original frame A beautiful work by the Bordeaux painter Claude Desseaux, depicting a lush bouquet in his famous green pot, a subject the artist presented at the 1976 Salon des Artistes Français. This luminous composition perfectly exemplifies the personal style developed by Desseaux during the 1970s. Constructed with broad strokes of texture and color, the work reveals a spontaneous, lively, and sensitive style of painting, in which light plays an essential role. The bouquet, rendered with great artistic freedom, seems almost to vibrate under the brush. The flowers stand out against an interior bathed in light, while the green vase--the true focal point of the composition--brings balance and depth to

the whole. The harmonies of whites, deep reds, ochres, and blues create a warm and intimate atmosphere characteristic of French painting of this period. Preserved in its original frame, the painting is also of particular interest because it is thoroughly documented. The inscriptions and information on the back allow the work to be identified and linked to the artist's participation in the 1976 Salon des Artistes Français, a detail particularly valuable to collectors.

Claude Desseaux A French painter with ties to the Bordeaux region, Claude Desseaux belongs to that generation of independent artists who enlivened the French art scene during the 1960s and 1970s. Self-taught, he developed a personal body of work inspired by observations of everyday life, landscapes, and still lifes. His work emphasizes color, light, and the sincerity of the brushstroke rather than passing trends. He participated in several art events and exhibited, notably, at the Salon des Artistes Français in 1976, where this work was presented. Although he remained relatively unknown, Claude Desseaux left behind an endearing body of work, representative of a free and generous style of figurative painting, rooted in the French tradition of 20th-century colorists. Today, his works are attracting growing interest among enthusiasts of regional painting and collectors seeking sincere artists whose paintings retain all their freshness and decorative power.

Our Opinion Both decorative, well-documented, and previously exhibited, this work offers numerous strengths. Its timeless subject, warm color palette, and clearly identified provenance make it a particularly appealing painting for a lover of 20th-century French art. A beautiful painting by Claude Desseaux, presented at the 1976 Salon des Artistes Français, preserved in its original frame and embodying all the sensitivity of a Bordeaux artist waiting to be rediscovered.
