The base of the structure features a delicate floral motif composed of five leaves in relief with a golden patina, adding a touch of elegance and light to the piece. The back of the mirror is carefully protected by an original wooden panel, held in place by a central metal frame. Perfect for adding a vintage, bohemian, or Art Deco touch to a dresser, a vanity, or a bathroom.
