Each glass features a beautifully cut diamond-patterned lower bowl that catches and reflects light brilliantly, contrasted by a smooth flared upper section. The elegant faceted stem rises from a distinctive sunburst-cut foot, creating a sophisticated silhouette that is both decorative and functional. The combination of geometric cutting and graceful form reflects the enduring influence of the Art Deco period and the remarkable skill of Baccarat's master
