Description

Large decorative wall plate in embossed and polychrome copper, Persia (present-day Iran), late 19th century. The piece features a refined decoration in the Oriental style, with a central vase from which elegant floral and plant motifs radiate, populated by a pair of birds facing each other. The composition, which displays remarkable ornamental balance, is enriched by a vibrant polychrome palette in shades of turquoise, blue, yellow, and black--colors traditionally used in Persian decorative arts. The decoration is applied to an embossed copper base, with the design also rendered in relief on the reverse side--a feature that attests to the quality of the craftsmanship.
