(See the image of the title "La Vérité" on the book.) The cherub with the trumpet: A symbol of Fame, which spreads news of great events. The cherub with the palm branch: A symbol of immortal glory and victory through the centuries. Medium: Oil on canvas, original stretcher * The canvas has not been crushed by the stretcher Condition: as shown in the photo Frame from "Schleipper," in very good condition, no missing parts, 17th-century Dutch style Provenance: former collection from East Flanders
