Byzantine gold pendant with four bezoars, believed to be magical antidotes to poisons. The structure, made of pure gold, features on the front half-moon-shaped and inverted heart-shaped glass pastes set between two small rubies on either side. Four hanging bezoars mounted as if they were pearls. An object of great esoteric fascination in absolutely exceptional condition. At the top is a cylindrical loop for attaching a cord or chain. The proposed date ranges from the 8th to the 10th century. A museum-quality piece of jewelry, of exceptional quality, integrity, and craftsmanship.
