The composition is crowned by a large openwork pediment centered on a blooming flower, lending the piece exceptional movement and decorative presence. The carvings demonstrate exceptional craftsmanship; note a few missing pieces, previous restorations, and a beautiful patina of age that lend it great charm and authenticity.
