A bronze statue with a brown patina depicting a Bacchante. She wears a flowing tunic that reveals her breasts and legs, and holds a bunch of grapes, the symbol of Bacchus. In Roman mythology, the Bacchantes (or Maenads in Greek mythology) are female worshippers of Bacchus (Dionysus). They take part in festivals held in honor of the god, where they engage in frenzied dances, sometimes accompanied by satyrs, while shaking tambourines and cymbals. Often intoxicated, they are associated with lust... Read more

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
