Description

A rare and elegant animal figure depicting an Asian elephant rendered in a naturalistic style, standing with its trunk raised and slightly curved. The animal is modeled with great finesse, the wrinkles of the skin rendered with precision beneath a glossy white glaze. The eyes are accented with ochre; the insides of the ears and the trunk feature delicate shades of pink and gray, while the tusks are left unglazed. This sculpture attests to the craftsmanship of Maison Samson, the renowned Parisian workshop founded by Edmé Samson in 1845, which specialized in reproductions and creations inspired by both Eastern and European styles. High-quality animal figurines are particularly sought after today for their decorative appeal and the finesse of their craftsmanship. Dimensions: H. 22 × W. 28 × D.
