Each sheet is accompanied by geometric tracings, cross-sections, and technical elevations evidencing preparatory work intended for the execution of sculptural or architectural works. The fineness of the linework, the quality of the proportions, and the presence of handwritten annotations underscore the nature of these studies or presentations, created in an 18th-century architectural or ornamental workshop.
