### Description

Fired ceramic tile painting by Pierre Bernotte, a painter born in 1929 in Lubersac (Corrèze) and died in 1996 in Limoges. Unique piece, signed lower left. Good condition. Stained wood frame. Image size : 9.7 x 9.7 cm. Frame size : 18.3 x 18.3 cm. From a very young age, Pierre Bernotte devoted himself to drawing and painting. In 1947, he sculpted his first "pebble heads" and created puppets. Pierre Bernotte began exhibiting in 1948. In 1949, he joined the Cohorte group, which brought together young artists from the abstract art movement (Pierre Giraud, Andrée Michaud, Laplagne, Desjarrige, Deglane, Papillaud). In 1950, he met Raoul Hausmann there, who played a key role in the Berlin Dada movement. With nearly 50 exhibitions, Pierre Bernotte left behind a rich body of work
