a niche of St. Peter's Basilica, Vatican City
(unveiled on January 31, 1936, by Cardinal
Pacelli, the future Pope Pius XII) Monument to
Giuseppe Manno, in the public gardens of
Alghero (1894) Statue of Saint Paul in the
Cathedral of Messina Equestrian monument to
the Knight of Italy, in Piazza Castello, in Turin
Statue of the Sorrowing Mother in Moncalieri,
inside the Dellachà Chapel Bust of Christ in the

the west pediment of the Victory Monument in
Bolzano (1927/28)[5] Valentino Arch or
"Artigliere Arch," on Corso Vittorio Emanuele
II/Valentino Park, in Turin, (1930) Bronze
bas-relief in the municipality of Cereseto
Monferrato dedicated to the Russian soldiers who
fell in World War I; never delivered to Nicholas
II and donated to the municipality by Riccardo
Gualino in memory of all those who fell in the
Great War Monument to Giovanni Paisiello, in
Taranto (1960) Many of his works are housed in
the Canonica Museum in Rome. He donated the
War Memorial to Vetralla. Others are located in
Stresa, a city to which he donated about twenty of
his sculptures, now housed in the Sala Canonica
of the Palazzo dei Congressi. A painting of
considerable value is the Portrait of Countess
Virginia Somalia Dal Pozzo, presented at the
1903 Venice Biennale.[6] In Russia Bronze statue
of Nicholas II, Tsar of All Russia Statue of
Alexander Sheremetev Statue of Beatrice
Monument to Nikolai Nikolayevich (destroyed;

the plaster and bronze model is on display at the Canonica Museum in Rome)In England Statue of Queen Victoria at Buckingham Palace; various statues and busts in the entrance hall of Osborne House on the Isle of Wight; various statues and busts in Nottingham Worksop and at Welbeck WoodhouseIn Turkey 2 monuments to Kemal Atatürk (models of the works are on display at the Canonica Museum in Rome)[7] Monument to the Republic (1928) in Taksim SquareIn Iraq Monument to Faisal I of Iraq (destroyed; the plaster model is on display at the Canonica Museum in Rome)In Vatican City Monument to St. John Bosco (a bust of the saint is also located in the Canonica Museum in Rome) and monument to Benedict XV; Monument to Sts. Peter and Paul (the sketches of the saints' statues are also located in the Canonica Museum in Rome). The statues are installed at the entrance to the Pontifical Lateran University. Bust of Cardinal Pietro Gasparri (from 1931), who signed the Lateran Pacts in 1929. The bust is located inside the Pontifical Lateran University.In Venezuela Statue of Simón Bolívar (an equestrian statue of the South American patriot is also located in the Canonica Museum in Rome)In Argentina Funeral monument to President José Figueroa Alcorta, at the Recoleta Cemetery.
