Raymond Dierickx (1904-1978): "The Nativity," oil on panel, 51 × 70 cm, mounted in a large black and gilded frame, 85 × 65 cm. Countersigned and titled on the back. In a typically Belgian landscape, a crowd of peasants precedes the Three Wise Men to worship the newborn Child. This wonderful Belgian artist was a true discovery for us! Even when found as loose, dusty sheets, these drawings, once prepared and framed, reveal the full extent of Dierickx's talent, which is akin to that of artists such as Nicolas Eeckmann, Fritz Van den Berghe, Constant Permeke, and others such as Anto Carte, depicting festivals, processions, and fairs in the grand tradition of Flemish painters dating back to the 17th century with the Brueghels, yet rendered with great modernity.
