History of Calvinism by Louis Maimbourg Paris, 1682, published by Mabre Cramoisy Quarto, bound in full calfskin of the period (26.5x20 cm) First edition, enhanced with an engraving of Maimbourg's portrait by Desrochers and illustrated with a frontispiece title page by Sevin, engraved by Gautrel, a title banner by Pollain engraved by Le Pautre, 7 initial letters, and 6 large and beautiful end-piece illustrations, as well as 6 illustrated chapter headings. A beautiful edition on fine laid paper with wide margins, exquisitely illustrated Decorated ribbed spine. Caps worn. Upper joint split. One corner chipped, scratches, scuffs, and various stains; leather missing from the back cover Interior shows water stains, sometimes severe, in the middle of the volume on several pages, minor worm
