Chest of drawers with a slight central projection in the Louis XVI style, Made of rosewood and mahogany veneer, Oak frame, Featuring a front with a slight protrusion, opening with three large drawers arranged in three rows, surrounded by light-wood moldings, with ring pulls and locks in gilded bronze, fluted side panels accented by a bronze trim, and rests on ring-mounted spindle legs topped with cleats, The top is crowned with veined white marble. Crafted in the Faubourg Saint-Antoine in the 1950s.
