Set of 6 "litron"-shaped cups made of Paris porcelain red stenciled mark on the reverse of each piece manufactured by Dilh and Guerhard, known as the Duc d'Angoulême located on Rue de Bondy, later Rue du Temple Late 18th century to very early 19th century Cups of identical shape but with different decorations and colors Several painters' marks painted in gold, notably L. E. Beautiful set in fairly good condition; slight wear to the gilding on each piece; note a star-shaped crack at the bottom of one saucer; restoration along the rim of one saucer and on the rim of one cup; the rest is in good condition A rare set from one of the finest Parisian manufacturers after Sèvres Saucer: 13.5 cm in diameter; cup: approximately 6 x 6.3 cm Feel free to ask any questions
