A lovely Louis XIV-style writing desk made of fruitwood, dating from the 18th century. With 4 turned legs connected by an H-shaped brace at the base. The base features 1 large drawer at the front. The top is adorned with a pretty molding around the edge that tapers its thickness. The drawer is fitted with a dovetail joint and features a lock with a working key. The lock dates from the 19th century. The base is from nearly 18th century, along with the apron, but the tabletop is from the late 19th century. The entire piece is fully doweled and in good condition. Sturdy table. H: 71.5 cm. Length: 86.8 cm. Width: 63.5 cm. Height below the apron: 58.5 cm.
