The doors are embellished with figurative panels depicting Oriental figures, while the carved side panels and the piece's monumental architecture underscore the exceptional quality of its craftsmanship. The cabinet opens via five doors, revealing numerous shelves that offer ample storage space. Fully decorated on its sides, it can be displayed as a centerpiece. This piece perfectly illustrates the
