Description

This piece is unique and stunning, and quite rare. Its main distinctive feature lies in the use of various undyed natural wools. The geometric patterns are thus created by selecting wools of various colors, resulting in a gentle harmony with subtle contrasts...A second distinctive feature is the use of the Sumak technique, which creates a raised texture across the entire surface. This technique, which originated in Persia, involves the use of a second weft thread to form each pattern on a pre-woven structure. There are very few pieces of this type. This technical and structural aspect ensures excellent stability on the floor, as the piece is relatively heavy for its rather compact dimensions, much like a hand-knotted rug...Its highly graphic composition--featuring a series of diamonds scattered across a field broken
