The center is decorated with a white hexagonal medallion in relief bearing the inscription "1910 - Diamond Jubilee - 1970", framing a stylized clover. This piece commemorates a diamond jubilee--marking sixty years of an event or institution--and reflects Wedgwood's penchant for special editions designed for collectors. The rim is adorned with an elegant garland of foliage and berries in white bisque, inspired by the neoclassical decorative repertoire developed by the manufactory beginning in the 18th century.
