Description

Portrait of a woman in an art collector's study looking at a print or watercolor on canvas in very good condition. The canvas is signed in the upper right corner, but the signature is partially worn. With an exhibition stamp. circa 1895/1910. frame 65x55 cm. Oil on canvas depicting, in an intimate format and "close-up," a young woman, seen from the back, sitting in an armchair, absorbed in observing a large print or watercolor she is holding in her hands. Dressed in a light white blouse accented with a blue ribbon, she is illuminated by light that contours her face, the nape of her neck, and the sheerness of the fabric. Her hairstyle, held in place by a tortoiseshell comb, is characteristic of the Belle Époque. In the background, a small painting depicting a female nude seen from behind hangs
