Bottle holder made of braided rope by Audoux & Minet - France, circa 1955-1960 A charming bottle holder made of braided rope and wood, an iconic piece by the famous French design duo Adrien Audoux and Frida Minet, leading figures in 1950s Mediterranean design. Crafted in their signature style, this piece combines a structure made entirely of twisted rope with a central body covered in brown leather, creating a design that is at once rustic, elegant, and perfectly representative of the spirit of the postwar French Riviera. The decorative coils and remarkable braiding showcase the artisanal craftsmanship for which the design duo became renowned. Based in southeastern France and closely aligned with the decorative aesthetic of the Vaclair Gallery in Cannes, Audoux and Minet developed instantly
