The epaulets are made of metal wire, likely silver or a similar alloy, given their dark, oxidized color. Each epaulet has a button at its upper end, allowing it to be attached to the shoulder of the uniform jacket. The long hanging fringes, also known as kannetilles, are characteristic of an officer's rank. Officer of the French National Guard from the era of the Second French Empire (circa 1852-1870).
