A beautiful and rare pair of vases with peacock motifs on opaline glass by Baccarat. This lovely design, of remarkable delicacy, is full of charm and poetry. Note that this is a true pair, as the peacocks face each other. The colors are rich, with the peacocks perched on a bird bath. There is also an elaborate floral design, notably featuring lovely mauve bellflowers. Typical of the Napoleon III era and Baccarat's productions from that time, these vases have a lovely diabolo shape on a small foot, with gold trim at the base and neck. In perfect condition (truly remarkable for vases over 150 years old!), 30 cm each, circa 1860. Superb antique vases, in impeccable condition and with a lovely design!
