A traditional Alsatian silhouette depicting a bourgeois interior scene with four figures in Louis XVI-era costumes: a gentleman, two ladies, and a child with a dog on a leash, set in a parlor featuring a mirror, a console table, and chairs. Silhouettes cut from black paper and applied to a hand-drawn background.
