Weight: 58 kg.\*ALFRED DÉSIÉ LANSON 1851-1938, French sculptor born in Orléans and died in Paris. Admitted to the École nationale supérieure des beaux-arts in Paris, he studied there under Pierre Louis Rouillard, François Jouffroy, and Aimé Millet. He made his debut at the 1870 Paris Salon with a plaster bust and a medallion. He went on to win numerous awards, including a Grand Prix at the 1889 World's Fair.
