A rare anatomical study depicting divergent strabismus, created around 1900. The face is made of polychrome papier-mâché with wax applications, mounted on fabric and featuring glass eyes. The divergent eye deviation is particularly expressive and reflects an educational intent to illustrate this eye condition. The piece is presented in its original oval frame made of blackened wood, under a Napoleon III-style domed glass cover. A unique object at the intersection of medical education, the history of ophthalmology, and the cabinet of curiosities. Late 19th century - early 20th century. Dimensions: Height: 37 cm.
