Description

A charming piece titled "The Little Goose Herder" in biscuit porcelain and patinated metal by George Omerth. This lovely group--depicting a young girl walking with her geese and her basket--features very fine chiseling. The geese and the girl's complexion are made of biscuit porcelain and are remarkably delicate. The rest of the piece is made of bronze-patinated metal. Look at the face and the details on the geese. This theme was often revisited in the 1900s; George Omerth created several versions of it, as did Daum in its glassware. 19 cm high, 15 cm long, in perfect condition, circa 1910, mold-stamped signature on the base. A very pretty and charming piece, beautifully rendered with this contrast of materials.
