Description

High-relief terracotta sculpture, hand-modeled and refined, depicting Flora, the Roman goddess of spring and flowers, surrounded by a swarm of winged putti moving among roses and garlands of foliage. The composition is set within an oval frame richly adorned with volutes, a fluted vase, and a stylized Baroque-inspired shell. The goddess is clad in flowing drapery and wears an opulent Baroque-inspired headdress. This decorative composition reflects the taste of late 19th-century Italian workshops for the rediscovery of Italian Baroque and Rococo models. Origin: Italy, probably Tuscany.
