Elegant bronze bust with a gilded patina depicting Louise Brongniart (1772-1845), a famous model immortalized by the great French sculptor Jean-Antoine Houdon. This sculpture faithfully reproduces one of the most iconic portraits of children in late 18th-century French sculpture. The youthful face is rendered with great finesse, revealing the full extent of Houdon's talent for capturing the gentleness and spontaneity of childhood. The elaborate hairstyle and the delicate modeling of the bust attest to high-quality craftsmanship.
