Description

A bracelet with 5 strands of 170 round, well-calibrated freshwater pearls. The strands are held together by a silver separator, creating a ribbon-like effect around the wrist. Freshwater pearls are composed entirely of mother-of-pearl produced by the mollusk. They are the result of an implant but are not nucleated, meaning they do not have an artificial nucleus at their center. The silky appearance of these pearls comes from the uniform density of the mother-of-pearl. They often have a silky, baroque look, recognizable by their small imperfections. Height of the pearls at the 5 rows: 2.5 cm Height at the clasp: 3 cm Open length: 18 cm Gross weight: 31 g 925 silver sliding tube clasp, hallmarked 925 at the end of the tube In very good original and used condition, worn very little; see photos for details Free
