Set of 6 silver cutlery pieces, "filets coquilles" pattern; the spoons are engraved with a coat of arms beneath a marquis's crown. Paris 1752-1753 (letter M). Master silversmith Antoine Chayé, admitted on August 6, 1747. Weight 1064g--length of forks 19.4cm--spoons 20.5cm. Condition: good, with signs of use. The shells are well-polished. A beautiful set of cutlery that is becoming increasingly difficult to find. These pieces date from the early Louis XV period.
