Description

The size is ideal--quite compact--and the proportions are unusual. This is a Kazak rug listed under the name "Tovuz." In reality, it is the work of the Armenian people. This origin is significant, and the rug features a low, precise knot--a sort of virtuosity in the weaving. The composition is classic, featuring three medallions set against a central field of Caucasian midnight blue. Within this field, numerous small motifs appear, such as rosettes, stars, and animal designs. Three borders frame the field, with a continuous water motif running along them. What is remarkable and characteristic of early Kazakh productions is, of course, the very high quality of the hand-spun wool. It is precisely this almost silky quality of the wool that gives the colors their full luminosity and depth. One speaks of purity. The harmony is
