The frame features a refined, continuous decoration of plant and leaf motifs, typical of Tuscan production of the period, enhanced by the warm amber tones of the Mecca gilding, which is still fully intact. This piece stands out for the authenticity of its surface, which has survived to the present day with its original patina, without any repainting or invasive interventions--a characteristic that is increasingly rare and highly prized by collectors. The natural wear of time and the slight abrasions on the gilding bear witness to its history and enhance its
