Description

A rural scene inspired by Post-Impressionism. The composition opens with a large porch built of cut stone--typical of traditional architecture--leading to a courtyard and a small house in the background. On the right, a pretty brick or pink-plastered facade features a window with shutters adorned with a vivid touch of red flowers. Oil on panel with a rich, textured quality, featuring impasto effects and a vibrant brushwork characteristic of French landscape painters of this period. The work is painted on an authentic "Carton Pochade" prepared by the prestigious art supplies company Sennelier - Paris (located at 3 quai Voltaire). The original label is present on the back, bearing the brand's historic logo. These lightweight supports were particularly sought after by artists for painting directly outdoors, "en
