The band opens to reveal a perfectly integrated, decorated drawer featuring a functional lock and a chiseled key, attesting to the attention to detail. The piece rests on four tapered, fluted legs of great elegance, joined by an X-shaped crossbar centered with a decorative medallion. The spindle legs provide a refined finishing touch, typical of the taste and style of the Napoleon III era. This table stands out for the quality of its veneer, the delicacy of its floral
