Description

This Art Deco sideboard, crafted from burl elm veneer around 1940, features a balanced silhouette in which the warmth of the precious wood harmonizes with a simple, geometric design. The elm burl, with its deep swirls and intense sheen, envelops the front with an organic movement that contrasts with the rigor of the lines, creating a subtle interplay between nature and structure. The alternation of open niches and a closed compartment creates a visual rhythm typical of late Art Deco, where functionality is adorned with understated elegance. The tubular metal handle extends this modernist aesthetic by adding a touch of cool verticality that highlights the door and accentuates the purity of the design. Inside, the two shelves feature the same warm hue, offering refined continuity even in the
