This small Louis XVI-style parlor table, crafted in the early 20th century, stands out for the elegance of its silhouette and the finesse of its cabinetry. Its top is crowned with luminous, delicately veined white Carrara marble, surrounded by an openwork brass band that emphasizes the purity of its lines and evokes the decorative codes of Neoclassicism. The base is adorned with refined marquetry combining rosewood and palisander, arranged in precise geometric patterns that attest to masterful craftsmanship. A discreet drawer is nestled within, opening via a small chiseled brass pull--a subtle detail that adds a touch of refinement. Resting on four tapered legs typical of the Louis XVI style, this pedestal table is finished with brass feet that provide stability and elegance.
