Description

This refined console table features rich veneering in various woods, embellished with the characteristic facing griffins flanking a central lyre--a distinctive motif of Giovanni Battista Milanese or Moroni's work, elegantly reproduced here on each side. The inlaid decoration alternates between floral motifs and leaf scrolls, with a carefully balanced interplay of color contrasts and wood grain. The front is enlivened by a drawer that is perfectly integrated into the inlay design. The top is made of original, high-quality Potoro (or Black Marble of Portovenere), while the tapered, finely contoured legs lend the piece a sense of grace and lightness.
