The face displays a serene expression and finely detailed hair, framed by a loose, airy veil that lends the work a sense of movement and the "whip-like" style typical of this period. The contrast between the smooth, matte finish of the face and the expressive, rough texture of the drapery makes this a visually captivating and highly tactile work. Mounted on a classic tapered base, it is ready to be displayed on a pedestal, a sideboard, or a mantelpiece. Design: Draped with pronounced relief, enhanced by a unique glaze--textured or with a "foamy" appearance. Earthy terracotta tones enhanced by a "sea foam" blue-green hue that is both vibrant and weathered.
