



## Large Stoneware Bottle - Germany, Creussen, 17th Century

### Description

Our large brown-glazed stoneware bottle is characteristic of the pottery produced in Creussen, a small Bavarian pottery town in the 17th century. Its purpose is quite simple: it is the predecessor of the small beer keg. The high-relief decoration, repeated in arched registers, depicts busts of women surmounted by small flowers and clusters of acorns enclosed within stars, likely a heraldic symbol. The original screw cap is made of pewter. This exceptionally rare object is sure to delight collectors of early period artifacts, enthusiasts of cabinets of curiosities, and beer historians.
