His face displays a look of blissful contentment, his eyes half-closed. This piece originally had a coppery patina, traces of which can still be seen around the back of the head and along the back. High density, as there are no hollow sections. Weight: 2.400 kg; height: 20.5 x width: 16.5 (cm). In good condition, aside from some slight normal wear and small chips (a larger one at the base of the right earlobe, but barely visible).
