Pen, ink, and wash on laid paper depicting a half-naked young woman being assaulted by a man in military uniform brandishing a torch .As she fell, the young woman dropped her jug, spilling water onto the floor.In 18th- and 19th-century art, the broken or overturned jug is a metaphor for the female body and the irreversible loss of innocence or virginity.
