Description

An 18th-century French school oil on canvas, attributed to the circle of Louis Léopold Boilly (1761-1845), depicting a young shepherdess in an intimate genre scene. The composition shows, on the right, a young girl wearing a straw hat and holding her staff. She stands out against the background with her light-colored blouse and blue apron. On the left is a seated figure, wrapped in a brown coat. In the background, in the dim light, one can make out the figure of the Virgin Mary, perhaps symbolizing winter. This painting features a rich color palette and a subdued, dark atmosphere that highlights the shepherdess. This 18th-century work has been recently restored.
