## Lucien Victor Delpy (1898-1967) Hsp "lively Port" Brittany

### Description

Lucien Vitor DELPY, Oil on Isorel, signed lower left. Dimensions: 27 x 22 cm and 47 x 32 cm in its Montparnasse wooden frame. A bustling port in Brittany, likely Concarneau. Painted after 1931, as it features a naval anchor. Admitted to the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris in 1914, he was a student of Fernand Cormon and Jean Pierre Laurens; then, after serving as a volunteer during World War I, he returned to Cormon's studio in 1919 and worked with Charles Fouqueray before setting up his own studio in Montmartre in 1923. He discovered Brittany in 1924, a region that would have a lasting influence on his work. He exhibited at the Salon des Artistes Français, where he won numerous awards, including a medal in 1927 as well as several prizes for his "colonial" works. Appointed painter to the Navy in 1931
