Description

- A green-colored cut crystal *Roemer* wine glass in the "Tommy" pattern from the Saint-Louis crystalworks, located in the Münzthal valley in the Moselle department (57) of the Lorraine region.- The Saint-Louis manufactory is the oldest in France; today, it is owned by the Hermès Group.- The "Tommy" pattern was created by the designer and decorator Joseph Bleichner (born 1887).- He served as head of the design, decoration, and fancy-ware departments at the Saint-Louis crystalworks.- As one of the company's principal designers and decorators--working there from 1903 to 1957--he produced a vast number of designs and decorative patterns for Saint-Louis.- His original design and decoration sketches are preserved at the Saint-Louis crystalworks museum.- From its

star-cut base to the brilliant reflections of its diamond and bevel cuts and beaded detailing, "Tommy" has remained timeless since 1928; its elegant lines grace the most refined table settings.- This green-colored crystal Roemer wine glass does not bear the Saint-Louis stamp, as it predates 1936.- Before 1936, Saint-Louis used a paper label featuring the company emblem--which would come off during the first washing--rather than the engraved signature and logo that began appearing on their glassware sets in 1936. - This green-tinted crystal Roemer wine glass is vintage and in good condition, though slight signs of use may be visible; it is handmade, which accounts for the minor variations sometimes found (such as height, weight, or patterns).- Far from being defects, these variations make this white wine glass a unique piece.- Appreciate them for the true value of the craftsmanship demonstrated by the master glassmakers at the Saint-Louis crystalworks.-

Reminder to buyers regarding the right of withdrawal for online sales via my Proantic store.- Must be read before purchasing from my sales site hosted by Proantic.- The right of withdrawal applies to sales made through my Proantic store.- The withdrawal period is 14 days following the buyer's receipt of the item or goods.- The buyer must notify me via email or registered letter--without needing to provide a reason or justification--within the 14-day statutory period following receipt of the parcel or item.- The buyer has the right to change their mind and benefits from the 14-day statutory cooling-off period; I respect this right.- Once this period has elapsed, the sale will be considered final and binding.- Return shipping costs (via postal service or carrier) are the buyer's responsibility in the event of withdrawal.- The buyer is required to return the item or goods within 14 days of receipt, in the same condition as received (free from breakage or damage) and in the original packaging. The return must use a shipping method with insurance coverage equal

to the sale price on my Proantic site (matching the level of insurance originally arranged by the seller). The buyer must also email me the proof of posting/drop-off receipt issued by the postal service or the shipping slip issued by the carrier. - All sales made via my Proantic site are covered by insurance purchased from La Poste at the time of shipping; this covers loss or theft up to the purchase price paid by the buyer.- La Poste does not provide insurance against breakage or damage to the item or object; coverage for parcel transport is limited to theft and loss.- Additional insurance covering breakage or damage--up to the price paid by the buyer on my Proantic site--is always purchased from the carrier when a third-party carrier is used.- The buyer risks legal penalties if they fail to return the item or object within the 14-day period and in good condition.- Refunds for the item or object will be issued within 14 days of the seller receiving the item or parcel and verifying its condition.- If the item or object is found not to match its original condition at the time of dispatch, the sale will be considered final and non-refundable; the right of withdrawal will not apply.- Refunds for the item or object will be issued using the same payment method (check, bank transfer, PayPal) used by the buyer for the original purchase on my Proantic site.- If payment was made via PayPal, the buyer is responsible for initiating the refund process--specifically, by navigating to the "Dispute" section and opening a dispute case involving themselves, PayPal, and the seller.- This notice regarding sales on my Proantic site is addressed to individuals prone to litigation or acting in bad faith. - I advise anyone prone to litigation or acting in bad faith not to purchase anything from my Proantic shop; this will save me from wasting time and money on legal proceedings.- Fortunately, my sales on Proantic generally go very smoothly, as the customers are usually pleasant, agreeable, and acting in good faith.- Best regards,- Mr. Pineaud.
